## Conservation Area Appraisal

### Your views wanted

East Herts Council has produced a Draft Appraisal of the Ware Conservation Area. The Appraisal identifies those elements which are considered to be important in forming the character of the Conservation Area and which should be preserved. The document also sets out a number of ideas for works which could improve the character of the area. Many non-listed buildings of quality and their associated features have been identified to be retained and protected. Other features including a number of walls and railings, the latter being alongside New River and the River Lea, are also shown to be protected. Important open spaces to be retained have been identified.

Extensions to the Conservation Area are proposed to include parts of Musley Hill, parts of Gladstone Road, land and trees between London Road and Grange Gardens and land and trees in the general vicinity of Kings Meads Nature Reserve and school playing fields, south side of River Lea. Also a minor extension on Star Street is proposed.

**A public meeting and exhibition will be held between 7pm- 9pm on Tuesday 8th December 2015 at Ware Priory, High Street, Ware SG12 9AL, where council officers will be present to answer your questions.**
