#### Ware Festival Health & Safety 2018

#### **Parade**

Maximum height of Float: 14ft

Insurance:If you are using a vehicle you should ensure that your existing motor insurance cover is adequate and includes injury to passengers travelling in or on your vehicle.

Please note that marshals cannot be held responsible for float passengers. (Particularly children).

You should be aware that alcohol should not be consumed whilst travelling on a moving vehicle.

Walking entries welcomed.

Ware Festival Committee will be responsible for the closing of the route to all traffic other than the parade.

All entries must follow the directions of the Marshals.

All entrants are responsible for their own First Aid arrangements.

All vehicles should carry adequate & suitable fire extinguishers. Please check with your driver.

Participants must not board or disembark whilst floats are moving. It is recommended that suitable steps be provided.

Care must be taken by those walking alongside moving floats to ensure they do not get hit or trapped under the wheels. Discuss with the driver any blind spots on the vehicle.

All participants below the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult at all times.

If the weather is hot suitable non alcoholic drinks should be provided for those taking part.

#### **Town Fair**

Stall holders are reminded of their obligations under current health & safety legislation of their duty of care to others.

Vehicles entering and leaving the Priory grounds must use hazard lights & proceed with care following the directions of the Marshals.

When setting up and dismantling care should be taken not to endanger yourselves or others.

If using any form of lighting or heating, please route the leads so as not to cause a trip hazard.

When using cooking facilities, ensure you have a suitable and adequate fire extinguisher to hand.

In the event of an emergency, follow the instructions given by the public address system and/or Marshals. Emergency exits will be displayed on boards in various locations throughout the grounds.
