Civic Dinner – April 30th, 2021

In line with the most recent Government advice, the Civic Dinner in 2021 will not be going ahead.

Annual Town Meeting/Mayor Making – 10th May

In line with recent Government advice, it is clear that the Annual Town Meeting and Mayor Making will not go ahead in its usual format. Alternate plans will be made.

Ware Festival 2021 – this was cancelled last month and there are no plans to reinstate those events.

Possible events:

Food Festival 2021

This usually takes place in late May. It is unclear at present whether this would be able to go ahead in May; suggestion is to plan for late June.

Summer Entertainment: It is plain that we will be able to go ahead with our programme of Summer Entertainment. This programme is almost complete at this stage. Opportunity is there to have the Conservatory Bar open on the dates the programme is in place.

Riverside Real Ale Festival

At the time of the cancellation of Ware Festival, discussion took place with the Real Ale Committee who were open to the idea of hosting the Real Ale Festival later in the year. Unless the Real Ale Committee would agree to a change in room (unlikely as I have explored this with them previously) then we would be looking at an October onwards date as we are unsure at this time when the Fletcher's Lea vaccination centre will close its doors.

Mini Rock in the Priory

At the time of the Ware Festival cancellation, discussion took place on holding a 'mini RiTP' later on in the year. By necessity this would need to be indoors, and the Drill Hall looks to be the most suitable venue. I will reopen a conversation with Drill Hall as to when they may start taking provisional bookings and what measure may have to be in place later along down the line.

Summer Activities

I am investigating the idea of hosting some outdoor activities for adults and children during the summer months. More to come on this.

Cinema

As it currently stands, we may be able to look at bringing our monthly cinema back from October onwards.
