

## **Ware Town Council Events 2021/22**

### **7<sup>th</sup> Riverside Real Ale Festival**

The Real Ale Festival, which usually takes place in July as part of Ware Festival, took place on 16<sup>th</sup> October across the Priory Hall and Conservatory. 400 tickets sold out online and a further 60 were sold on the door – many people without tickets were turned away. Local bands Ware Ukulele, Test the Waters and The Bengeo Blues Club supported the day/evening. The beers/ciders sold out by 10.30pm. The figures are yet to be finalised but it is clear there will be a healthy profit which will benefit the Ware Festival charities, Herts Mind Network and Ware Foodbank.

### **Civic Service**

The Mayor's Civic Service took place at St. Mary's Church on Sunday, October 24<sup>th</sup> followed by Afternoon Tea at the Priory. The Service and Tea were well attended.

### **Eco aWare**
