

# Competition Rules



## Entry Information

- Entry is free
- To enter, complete the competition **entry form** and **email** it to **allotments@waretowncouncil.gov.uk** together with a **photograph showing the measurements** of your sunflower
- Please do not post any applications. It is more eco-friendly to submit your entries digitally.
- To avoid administrative burden, incomplete entries will not be judged

## Measuring the Face of the Sunflower

- Do not include the petals, only measure the face of the sunflower where the seeds are
- If the sunflower face is flat, use a tape measure to show the widest width of the sunflower vertically or horizontally
- If the sunflower face is rounded, use a tape across the widest width of the sunflower, holding it against the curvature of the sunflower face
- If you research ways to measure sunflowers online, there is more than one method in use. For our competition, we will be using the above methods.

# Competition Rules

## Privacy

- Photographs submitted may be used on social media. If you wish to protect the privacy of any child entering the competition, please do not include their face in the photograph showing the measurements of the sunflower.

## Rules

- One entry per child, per allotment garden
- Entries must be received by midnight on the 18th of July 2022
- The sunflower plant needs to be growing in the ground, on a Ware allotment plot
- The sunflower plant needs to be visible on the plot in the three weeks following the 18th of July 2022
- In your sunflower photo/s, include your tape measure clearly showing the measurements of the sunflower face
- The judge's decision is final
- Enjoy the competition as intended, fun for the family
