Library of Things

- We are currently working with 16 councils across London and have provided them with the attached solution.
- For locations outside of London that may have smaller budgets, we are developing units
 with a smaller footprint and lower upfront cost. Also outside of London we would expect the
 council to recruit the maintenance technician and undertake the marketing outreach. The
 other big difference will be that councils outside of London will retain all the rental income
 and pay Library of Things a software licence fee. (In London we retain all the income to
 pay our technician and fund the marketing outreach.)
- In London we charge a £15k set-up fee to councils who want us to design, install and operate the service.
- Outside of London we are happy to negotiate a reasonable fee for advice for your set-up and ongoing operations. However, if that is beyond your budget, you can just sign-up to our software licence.
- We would love you to take advantage of our experience and expertise to ensure that the community asset you develop in your community is sustainable for the long-term.
- Below are the operating costs for one of our mature top performing sites. My gut tells me
 that it might take Ware 2-3 years to get to a comparable level.
 With regard to the numbers below it might be useful to note that (a) because this location is
 two years old, the replacement cycle will have kicked in with some tools coming to the end
 of their viability and (b) going forward we have reduced the annual lock software cost closer



Notes from our meeting:

- The costs are very much negotiable.
- It is possible to DIY a locker set up but I feel it is a lot of work for very minimal savings.
- They are very keen to have one opened in Hertfordshire and suggested there may some sort of sweetener if we are the first.
- If we opted to not include carpet cleaners and jet washers it would significantly reduce the expense of ongoing maintenance.
- They have not experienced problems with public causing significant damage to the items.
- Community buy-in is very important and marketing ahead of launch plays a key role in this.
- I think there's potential to link up with Ware reuse shop or local Fix-it Dave for the repairs and maintenance. I believe he suggested it was about 20 hours per month for maintenance.
- Sourcing the items from fewer manufacturers is better for repairs- requires less expertise and easier to source replacement parts.
