Hertford Cycle Hub are applying for funding to deliver the Herts3Cycle project for Ware residents. Herts3Cycle initiative collects disused/unwanted bicycles from a variety of sources, most prominently the local recycling centre and resident donations, these are repaired and donated to local residents in need (for example children on free school meals and adults living in areas of deprivation). We currently have x30 bikes that have already been donated that need repairing, servicing and matching to suitable, eligible residents living in Ware.

The breakdown of costs required for these x30 bikes can be seen below, note this includes each recipient receiving a brand new fitted helmet and lock as well.

## Cost per bicycle:

Cost per bike (approx.)	£147.99
Co-ordination and management of the scheme	£35.00
Lock	£23.00
Helmet	£29.99
Repairs budget	£20.00
Service / PDI check	£40.00


£147.99 x 30 bikes = £4,439.70 required.
