<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For an interment in a new grave, the Exclusive Rights of Burial must always be purchased. Purchasing the Exclusive Rights of Burial means that you do not own the land but have the exclusive right, during the period stated in the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial, to say who can be buried in the grave. 2. The pre-purchase of burial or cremated remains plots is not permitted. Grave spaces are assigned at the time of arranging an interment. 3. The Ware Town Council reserves the right to select burial spaces. 4. Memorials are subject to approval in line with Ware Town Council Burial Regulations. 5. The Ware Town Council will recover charges for the interment of children, up to the age of 18, from the CFF (Children's Social Fund for England). 6. The Ware Town Council maintains the cemetery grounds. Graves themselves are maintained by grave owners. 7. Please see the Burial Regulations on our website for further information.
