Stewardship

We will ensure a regular inspection and maintenance regime to maintain the assets to a standard suitable for use by the community, local groups and sports clubs.

Promotion

We will promote the facilities to ensure that the wider community, local groups and sports clubs are aware of the facilities and how to access them.

Partnership working

- We will continue to work with user groups to promote the use of Ware Lido.
- We will continue to work with local sports clubs who currently hire the Lido.
- We will continue to work with local schools to develop a programme of swimming lessons at the Lido.
- We will continue to work with local youth groups to develop use of the facilities.
- We will work with Forever Active East Herts to develop the use of our facilities.
- We will seek grant funding opportunities to develop a programme of activities to widen the use of our facilities by those who are less active.
