





Christmas 2025

With the Town Centre Steering Group, a plan has been agreed to promote an in person public consultation in March. At this event, information will be available about the legislation and guidelines within which we need to operate. The main purpose however is to pose_several questions about what the public would like to see in future lighting schemes. The results will be presented at Full Council in April for councillors to consider.

Town Council Website

There have been updates and releases of functionality on the new website, that we requested, to improve how council and local events are listed. The What's On pages have had increased views. We are working on

improving accessibility to replace, remove and tag or highlight/offer alternatives for non-accessible features like some PDF's and images.

Spring Clean 2025

We have accounted for another spring clean in the 2025/26 budget. We are hoping, however, that some UKSPF funding that East Hert's still has available will be confirmed as allocated to us.

Town Map

Our local designer has produced an A5 folded map with a business directory and illustrations of local attractions. It is currently being proofed and will be ready to print in March.

Community Banking Hub

Cash for Access UK have been unsuccessful in securing a permanent location on the High Street. We have contacted property agents to help in the search.
